### **SESSION DIGEST**

The Session met on Monday, 10 October 2016.

The following actions were approved:

- Registration drive: A student voter drive, to be held in our Mendenhall Street parking on Saturday, 22 October. The sponsoring organization is NextGen. They will do all the work for the drive, including cleanup afterwards. (Note: this event was subsequently changed to another location and did not take place at PCoC).
- Renter: The contract of one of our tenants who has not paid rent for a number of months will be terminated.
- More Light Presbyterians: Although we have already joined More Light Presbyterian, we will pay its \$200 membership fee.
- New Elders: The committee for nominating a new class of elders will consist of the three departing members—Morgan Glover, Lem Cox, and Nancy Schaefer--plus 4 PCoC members from outside the Session.
- Weddings: People from outside our church may hold weddings in the church for a fee of \$500 plus \$250 for the church's wedding coordinator and expenses for janitorial service. The church's wedding coordinator will be a new position. Lem Cox volunteered to fill it until someone could be found for the position.
- Personnel manual: The Session approved the new personnel manual drawn up by the Personnel Committee.
- Interim pastor: Ralph Cauthen, chair of the Interim Support Committee, reported that Dale Walker, our liaison with Salem Presbytery, will lead the Session in an evaluation of Mark Sandlin's performance as interim pastor and in completing the procedures to renew his contract for a second year. This meeting will be part of the Session's November meeting.
- Salem Presbytery: The Session elected Barbara North to represent the church at the next Presbytery meeting, to be held on Saturday, November 12, 2016.
