Report of The Pastoral Nominating Committee

The Pastoral Nominating Committee is now in a very time-consuming phase in the process of calling a pastor. We have reviewed dozens of pastor information forms (PIF) and selected a few for phone interviews. If the phone interviews do not produce a suitable candidate, we will resume review of PIFs.

We want to assure the congregation that we are working hard to find the best possible candidate for Covenant. Please recognize that most of these pastoral searches take at least a year because the PIFs are submitted on a continuing basis throughout the year and one of those could be the ONE.

We are also calling a pastor, not hiring a pastor. It is a three-way partnership with the Presbytery having the primary responsibility for oversight of the process; the pastoral candidate accepting the call or not; and the Congregation voting to call the pastoral candidate or not.

Because Covenant has two gatherings with different needs and worship styles, this process is more complicated and possibly will take several months. We are getting information forms from all over the U.S. and giving them our attention. Our goal is to find a good speaker with progressive theology, skills to work well with the congregation, be able to help our church grow and become even more viable and active in the community.

As you know, we are a small church with an older congregation and an aging building. We wish to call a minister who will see this challenge as an opportunity. The interviews are a two-way conversation and we will do our best to impress the candidate as well.

At this time, we would like to ask that the congregation trust the committee to use due diligence in searching for our pastor. The committee is considering each candidate on their merits in relation to the parameters set in the Congregational Sunday Meetings that were led by our interim pastor. This material was listed in a summary of those meetings and the committee used that information to write the Mission Statement and prepare our Ministry Information Form. Both documents are posted in the Fellowship Hall.

Weekly updates to the congregation are not helpful due to the amount of research being done. A monthly update is printed in each month's newsletter. We cannot and will not provide candidate names due to personnel issues, but we will be glad to answer your questions about our progress.


Nancy Pitkin Announces Departure in June
