Session Meeting Minutes, July 10, 2018

The church is in desperate need of a new boiler for heat this coming winter. A new boiler will cost more than \$40,000.00. The Resource Committee has developed a plan to pay for a new boiler with a combination of cash on hand and a loan from the Presbyterian Church (USA) Investment and Loan Program. The Session approved the loan application and the loan has been submitted. Jeff Farlow is working to locate a used boiler which would reduce our initial cost. In the spring the church will have a capital campaign to raise funds for this and other needed capital improvements.

The next regularly-scheduled Joint Service will be August 26th at 10:00 a.m., followed by our annual ice cream social put on by the Fellowship Committee. We will also share a Joint Service on the following Sunday, September 2nd at 10:00am (Labor Day weekend).

The Personnel Committee has met with Dave Fox and Nancy Pitkin to clarify their respective roles for our music program. Nancy Pitkin will continue as our Director of Music and will have responsibility for the overall music program for the church. She will lead the Bell Choir and the Men's Quartet. Dave Fox, under Nancy's leadership, will lead the Chancel Choir.

The church is looking for an outreach program that can make a difference to our community and we are exploring working with a local company that is recycling old denim clothing to make insulation.



It's A Joint Service and A Sundae Sunday on August 26th!




