#### Session Meeting Minutes, May 14, 2019

Guest Joy Saleeby cited plans for Rev. Sandlin's Installation Service Reception on June 23. After much discussion, the Session approved the budget and instructed Joy to proceed with the plans.

Nancy Schaefer reported on the Presbytery Meeting in Taylorsville on May 14.

The Resource Committee reported that contributions were up; we are not yet in the black, due to gas costs being over budget, and printer payments. Resource is continuing to prioritize repairs as funds become available.

Nancy Schaefer, Clara Kelly, and Lem Cox transported mulch and distributed it in the play area. The Session is most appreciative of their hard work. There was discussion on replacing the weatherworn toys. It was requested that the Sanctuary pews be repaired before the June reception or, if possible, before the May 19th concert.
