Session Meeting Minutes, June 11, 2019

Final details concerning Rev. Mark Sandlin's Installation Service were discussed. Salem Presbytery requested that an offering be taken up during the service. We discussed placing a notice in the News & Record (we did).

PCOC and U-Kirk will host the monthly Salem Presbytery Meeting on November 10, 2020. A committee will be formed in 2020 for planning the details of the meeting, meals, etc.

PCoC is over budget by \$10,212. Part of that is due to building repairs, which includes repairs for the second and third floor bathrooms. We have contacted two vendors to provide estimates for needed roof repairs. We are also making repairs to the pews in the Sanctuary.

The Nursery is closed and locked for the summer; there is no one to supervise children, oversee nursery maintenance, or cleanup. We have created a "Kids' Box", available on the back table in the Sanctuary, which contains books, crayons, and coloring pages, for small children to use during the services. There is also no children/youth program this summer, as we currently have no children's program leader

The Session plans to invite the Director of the UNCG's Center for New North Carolinians program Thriving at Three, Krycya Flores, to the June 30th Joint Service to make a short presentation about the program.

Jane Cauthen, our Pastoral Care Associate, served four people with visits and calls, and two other providers were involved with four individuals in June.
