Session Meeting Minutes, November 12, 2019

The Session and the Resource Committee are still researching our options for replacing the roof and facilitating the finances needed for the project.

After Gateway has expressed interest in further ground floor expansion; discussion is still underway.

The Building and Grounds Committee is choosing a new company for snow removal.

The Elder Nominating Committee has been selected and has met. Members: Nancy Schaefer, Annie Oakley, Charlie Finch, Clara Kelly, and Dave Sheets. The Resource Committee reports that giving has fallen behind \$10,366 as of the end of October.

Giving to fulfill the Capital Campaign pledges stands at \$26,700 received of the pledged amount of \$28,520. Our 2020 requested budget is minus \$25,570 to be a balanced budget. So far, the pledges received for 2020 giving are averaging downwards (\$3,000) from last year (\$3,500). Many pledge cards are still outstanding; the congregation has been reminded to please turn them in.

The Worship Committee distributed the 2020 Joint Services Schedule. Worship is also planning the Christmas Eve Service, "An Appalachian Christmas", with lots of music from PCoC and guests artists.

The Spiritual Formation Committee, together with the Personnel Committee, has hired a Nursery attendant.

The Interiors Committee continues to work on the courtyard project. Holiday decorating took place on Sunday, Nov. 24<sup>th</sup>, after the 11:15am service, with volunteers assisting.

The Fellowship committee advises that the meals following 2020 Joint Services will take place on even-numbered months, with the exception of Stewardship Sunday at the end of September, 2020.

The Outreach Committee will begin a holiday drive to restock the UNCG Spartan Open Pantry beginning Saturday, December 7<sup>th</sup>, with a food drive in the Mendenhall St. parking lot. Other local area churches have been invited to take part, including UKirk. Several nearby neighborhood groups have also indicated willingness to participate. Outdoor drive-by drop-offs will be on Saturdays in December: Dec. 7th, 14<sup>th</sup>, and 21<sup>st.</sup> Indoor contributions will be collected on Sundays in December: Dec. 8<sup>th</sup>, 15<sup>th</sup>, and 22nd. Volunteers are needed on these dates. Outreach also advises we are close to meeting the criteria needed to become a PCUSA Hunger Action Church. Our ongoing food collection to benefit Greensboro Urban Ministry yielded 97pounds of food collected and delivered in October. Mary's House is still experiencing difficulties but we remain committed to helping their mission as soon as they are on firmer ground. Annie Oakley, Clerk of The Session
