A Congregational Letter from Rev. Sandlin

Hello PCoC Family,

I have to admit that nowadays, I spend a lot of time looking forward to our first Sunday back together. Undoubtedly, it will be different, with social distancing and various forms of personal protection, but it will be a joyous kind of "different."

As to when that day will be, that is very difficult to say. The Presbytery is asking us to continue to "suspend live worship for the foreseeable future, at least through the month of May." Ultimately, Governor Cooper and our Session will have the final say as to when we gather again, but we certainly give heavy weight to the Presbytery's recommendations.

With that in mind, I'm working on being able to broadcast our Sunday message via Zoom in addition to the Facebook and YouTube broadcasts we already do. The Zoom broadcast will only be available to PCoC folks and will give us a chance to "see" each other during worship. It also should give us the ability to have a little taste of the Sanctuary during our Sunday broadcasts as well. Once it's up and running (probably next week), we'll send out an email with all of the details on how you can access it.

As you might imagine, this is a financially difficult time for most churches and we certainly are not an exception to the rule. Giving is considerably down for the month of April. Admittedly, that's not such a big surprise, being that we haven't been able to gather together for over a month, but it is a big deal in terms of our budget. Session Meeting Minutes, April 14, 2020

OLD BUSINESS

Revisit decisions made during called meeting of March 25th:

Adjustment of rents for building tenants. Decision: Mark (with input from Kate) to make decisions on rent adjustments on case by case basis, and will ask each tenant to do the best they can making their rent.

Closure of church office during virus pandemic. Decision: will continue to keep office closed, but have periodic checks on building from Pastor Mark, Kate, Mark Cable, Clara Kelly, Lem Cox. Kate checks phone messages and email several times daily. When authorities open the city up to previrus movement of people, will revisit the closure.

Scheduling a post-Easter church service. Decision: "Easter" service will be held on the first Sunday after restrictions on meetings are lifted, we can again meet in the building and there is sufficient time to plan the service. We will be flexible about details of the joint service. Will plan to publicize this service in the community.

NEW BUSINESS

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Resource: Financial report from Nancy Schaefer (sent to Session members by Nancy), report by Tom Taylor. We plan to postpone making unnecessary expenditures. We are concerned about fall-off in pledges; discussion about sending, after restrictions are lifted, a reminder to each member about what they pledged and what they actually paid.

Worship: Mark; discussion on suggestions for enhancing his Sunday broadcast.

Spiritual Formation: Marcia; book study group is continuing via conference calls and is discussing chapters in the Neal Walsch book started before movement restrictions began.

Building & Grounds: Don; has done walk-arounds in and out of the buildings and they look good; continuing to get quotes on needed work.

Interior: Barbara; decision on all buildings and grounds work: hold off on spending on nonessential work until future reevaluation of financial status.

Communication: Tom; working to enhance church website.

Fellowship: no report.

Outreach: Ann; has not met, but Joyce Powers took supplies of donated toilet paper collected before the virus to the UNCG Spartan pantry.

Personnel: Ralph; posting of search for Music Director has been delayed but will be done soon so that we'll have a pool of applicants to interview operations resume.

Congregational Care: have had 3 deaths in the congregation this year. We plan to set up a phone tree to reach each member during the quarantine period.

Long Range Plan discussion: The Session plans to set up a series of meetings for visioning and planning, but this needs to be done in person, so will take place when operations resume. In the meantime, Don and Mark will discuss how we can pre-load the process.
