Session Meeting Minutes, May 9, 2023

OLD BUSINESS

Revisioning Update: Interested party working to see if the financial numbers work, which are expected to, so we are one step closer to positive outcome of process. We discussed forming an ad hoc committee to determine what PCoC furnishings should be kept, donated, or discarded, and other details. Mark said he would talk to the Revisioning Committee about this.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

Resource Committee: Time to publicize the Farrell Scholarship. Session members reviewed both long and short versions of financial reports and voted in favor of the traditional short version. We were in the red \$7K for April but the cash reserves are up. In all, we are about where our finances were expected to be at this time.

Spiritual Formation: Sunday Study group continues to meet on Zoom and is reading Michael Beckwith's *Life Visioning*. No Communion service is currently being planned.

Buildings and Grounds: Pipe leaks successfully repaired.

Grounds: Michael is currently mowing on Fridays in preparation for Sunday services.

Fellowship: July 2 Fellowship lunch will feature a Revisioning Committee report, so will be restricted to PCoC members.

Outreach: Committee members prepared meals for Habitat for Humanity volunteers; Out of the Garden Project volunteering continues; assisted Vandalia Presbyterian Church to move donated food into their pantry.

Congregational Care: there were 51 contacts during April from 10 providers.

Farrell Scholarships Now Available

The Farrell Scholarship, established in 1994 by the William and Nell Farrell family, is an endowed Scholarship with grants provided from the accrued interest of the endowment. The scholarship is open to members or friends of the congregation of Presbyterian Church of the Covenant and to their children who find themselves in need of a college, technical, or theological education to obtain mean-ingful employment, and who lack the financial means to complete this education. Priority is given to congregation members and their children in greatest need. Note "Farrell Scholarship" in the subject line or on the envelope. Deadline is July 15 2023. A committee will review applications and make award recommendations to the Session by early August. This Scholarship is a grant without the necessity or expectation of repayment. The scholarship may be renewed yearly by reapplication.

For the first four months of 2023 the church received revenues of \$76,623. Sixty percent (60%) of that amount came from contributions and the remainder was rental income.

During that same time period the church spent \$84,043. Nearly 90% of that amount was spent roughly equally on personnel expenses and maintaining the church buildings. This resulted in deficit spending of \$7,420 through the end of April.

The church's budget for 2023 projected a loss for the first four months of \$7,180, so the net loss is close to what was expected.

On the second Sunday of each month we take up a special offering during our weekly Sunday service for the PCUSA hunger initiative, Pennies For Hunger. Please designate :P4H on the memo line of your checks; cash contributions are also welcome. This month's donation will be collected on Sunday, June 11th.

PCOC's Wednesday Night Fellowship Supper is on hiatus for the summer months. We hope to resume the dinners in the autumn.
