A Letter from Reverend Sandlin

Hello PCoC Family!

For those unable to be with us at the hot dog luncheon on Sunday, August 27th, I want to share with you an update presented following lunch from the Revisioning Committee.

We have received a Letter of Intent (LOI) to purchase the building and property from the investor group we've been working with this year. Keep in mind, this is the very earliest stage of moving towards an offer to purchase, but it does demonstrate a desire and intent from the investor group to make the purchase. The LOI included a potential purchase price and the figure is an acceptable place from which to negotiate. The LOI terms also includes an escrow deposit that would be made as an act of good faith.

We are meeting with our legal counsel to review the LOI and suggest changes we wish to see before the LOI will be signed and returned to the investor group. We've also informed the Presbytery of this next step in our process.

Additionally, we've assembled a Preservation Committee to begin looking at the church's furnishings and possessions in the building to make decisions about what we can or need to keep, and then what to do with all that remains. If you know of the important history of any item in the building, please let us know as we begin the process. Call or email the church office.

While we know the path we are on is the best decision for us, it is a difficult path, but it will lead us to a place where our PCoC family can thrive.

Thank you all for your continued support, thoughtful questions, and wise counsel throughout this process. You are greatly valued in all of this.

Session Meeting Minutes, August 8, 2023

OLD BUSINESS

Revisioning Update: We anticipate receiving a formal letter of intent from the group of companies coordinated by the Flywheel Foundation. PCoC has been sent a questionnaire to fill out re: physical aspects and history of our property. The group is paying for evaluations and appraisals of the buildings, showing a financial commitment also. In future, the Session and then the congregation will need to approve the plans for the project, when they are received. We are in talks with First Presbyterian about the possibility of relocating our offices and worship to their buildings, including a possible location for After Gateway.

Church Stuff committee: The Preservation Committee has been formed to make decisions on future disposition of unneeded furniture, accessories, etc. Committee member are Betty Allen, Ann Finch, Annie Oakley, Vickie Wallace, Barbara North, Charlene Holler, Elsie Hutchens, and Kate Baird.

Registered Agent Update: Kate has agreed to be the Registered Agent for the church and the necessary paperwork has been filed.

NEW BUSINESS

Stewardship luncheon: The proposed September date has been changed, and the luncheon will be held in October, date TBA.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Resource Committee: Two Ferrell scholarships @\$1300 each have been awarded.

Finances: We are still running a deficit, with parking lot income down.

Worship: The committee will meet in October, date TBA.

Spiritual Formation: The Sunday Study Group continues reading "Holy Envy."

Buildings and Grounds: Thanks to Mark Cable for his masterful job of locating and fixing the big water leak for only \$4K. At his request, the Session has approved two \$50 gift cards for the two people who helped him.

Exterior: Weekly grounds work continues. August work day activities will depend on the temperature.

Communications: Church flyer is updated and available.

Fellowship: The Hot Dog and Ice Cream Social is on Sunday, August 27th, followed by an update from the Revisioning Committee.

Outreach: Ongoing outreaches include: funds collection for Pennies for Hunger; monthly work day on the Out of the Garden project; help with Vandalia Presbyterian's food drive, including plastic bag collection; collection of school supplies for Foust Elementary School. October will be "Get the Goat" month, raising funds to purchase livestock for a family selected by the Presbyterian Hunger Project.
