A Letter from Reverend Sandlin

Hello PCoC Family!

Many of you have heard me talk about how much I appreciate the work of Dr. Bart Ehrman, who is an American New Testament professor and scholar at UNC – Chapel Hill. If you haven't read his works, I cannot recommend him highly enough.

Dr. Ehrman has amassed quite a following on social media (and with good reason). A few weeks ago, he shared a meme that said, "Pastors are, as a rule, reluctant to teach what they learned about the Bible in seminary." Not so surprisingly, hundreds of people replied who essentially agreed with his observation.

I, however, was fortunate enough to be able to share that meme saying, "I'm am thankful to be at a church where I actually do get to talk about what I learned and continue to learn. As a matter of a fact, most of the congregation actually expects me to."

A couple of you even commented echoing the fact that that was the reality here at PCoC.

So this note is to say, "Thank you." Thank you for creating that kind of space. Thank you for being open-minded enough that we can all have important conversations about sacred and other important topics. Session Meeting Minutes, June 12th, 2024

OLD BUSINESS

Revisioning Update/offer on buildings: Flywheel is in process of getting a LOI to present to church. Revisioning Committee is trying to speed up the process. Alternate plan is still in place.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Resource Committee: Financial statement reviewed; reserves are dwindling. The Stewardship Luncheon will now be on October 20, 2024.

Spiritual Formation: Sunday Study group finishing current book. Discussed changing back to meeting in person. Mark pointed out that it is possible to have hybrid meetings, both Zoom and in person. Mark is willing to facilitate.

Buildings and Grounds: Recent vandalism by person officially unknown (although a likely suspect is known) including broken windows. Repairs are ongoing.

Interior: Mark mentioned resumption of efforts by the Church Furnishing committee. Thanks to the efforts of David Johnson and Roxanna Wennberg, about 3/4 of the toys, etc., in the playroom have found new homes.

Fellowship: Fellowship Dinner on 30 June with church providing hot dogs and hamburgers; congregants asked to bring sides and desserts. The Cauthens and the Norths are looking to have an ongoing relationship between the Islamic community and PCoC. Beth is planning to have a Soul Collage workshop in September.

Outreach: Out of The Garden Project volunteers still serve each month. Pennies for Hunger raised \$333. We are still assisting the Vandalia Food Pantry. We provided lunch for Habitat for Humanity crews in May and will again in September. \$350 raised by congregation for Heifer project; that amount was matched by the committee to total \$700, which bought a barnyard full of animals. In July we'll start to collect school supplies for Foust Elementary for delivery in August. We're getting a representative of Spartan Open Pantry to make a presentation to the congregation.

Personnel: The music director now has a signed contract with the church.

Presbytery meeting: Nancy attended the May meeting and her report was sent separately to Session members. Big surprise from this was that Vandalia Presbyterian Church is selling its property.
