## Session Meeting Minutes, October 9th, 2024

#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

Margaret shared a Transformational Ministry guide from the Presbytery. We voted to invite Jodi Lingan, the Transformational Ministry guide representative, to the November Session meeting, since this is an appropriate time for us to receive guidance on what is happening with the church.

#### **OLD BUSINESS**

**Revisioning Update/offer on buildings:** Plan A group met with Plan B group and our representative David Kolosieke about possible joint venture. We need to create a back-up Plan C.

#### **COMMITTEE REPORTS**

**Resource Committee**: Stewardship luncheon/meeting was on Oct.27<sup>th</sup>. PCoC's insurance premiums and deductibles will increase as of November. There will no longer be coverage for the roof due to its age. Current roof repairs estimate is \$4.8k. Reserves continue to dwindle. Committee discussed necessity to formulate a "Plan C" for the building sale. The Treasurer's report was presented by Nancy.

**Spiritual Formation**: Sunday Study group continues to meet on Zoom, still reading Jim Dollar's Old Preacher's Manifesto.

**Buildings and Grounds**: Roof has significant deterioration and repair costs will be \$4K; will give update on this at next meeting.

**Grounds**: Mowing for the season has ended; work day was Oct. 26<sup>th</sup>.

**Interior**: Working on decisions regarding setting up Christmas decorations.

Communications: The church's website needs considerable updating, not currently in budget.

**Fellowship**: Committee met Oct. 21st to formulate plans for next year. Upcoming concerts include Derek Webb on Nov.15 and Flamy Grant late January 2025.

**Outreach**: Out of The Garden volunteers continue food prep. Pennies for Hunger has raised \$500 in 2024. Vandalia food pantry volunteer workdays continue; we served Habitat for Humanity volunteers lunch on Sept. 28 and breakfast to their Pride Build volunteers on Oct. 5<sup>th</sup>. The annual CROP Walk on Oct. 6th raised over \$1140, which will be donated to local organizations. We continue to support People to People Liaison, the Farmer's Curb Market, Faith Action Intl. We donated bikes to recycle and toys to Goodwill. Our annual donations drive for UNCG Spartan Open Pantry is in December.

Personnel: Margaret. Mark Sandlin's review took place.

Congregational Care Report: September saw 35 contacts by 6 providers.


